Safety, security and access incidents

Incidents of threats and violence affecting aid workers and aid delivery.

Africa

Mali

02 August 2022: In Inagam area, Menaka region, an armed group hijacked a INGO vehicle. **Source:** [ACLED](#)¹

03 August 2022: In Warasso village, Sikasso region, suspected Jamaat Nusrat al-Islam wal Muslimeen (JNIM) militants hijacked two INGO vehicles. The militants later returned the vehicles. **Source:** [ACLED](#)¹

05 August 2022: In Nongo-Souala village, Sikasso region, suspected JNIM militants hijacked two NGO vehicles. **Source:** [ACLED](#)¹

Niger

06 August 2022: In Garin Dogo village, Diffa region, suspected ISWAP militants fired gunshots at an NGO vehicle. No casualties were reported. **Source:** [ACLED](#)¹

South Sudan

09 August 2022: Near Longole village, Ikotos county, Eastern Equatoria state, unidentified armed men ambushed a marked Caritas vehicle, killing a male Caritas aid worker and injuring several civilians. Myanmar

23 July 2022: In Mingalartaungnyunt township, Yangon East district, Yangon region, the Myanmar military detained a 45-year-old volunteer aid worker and former NLD member. He died within 24 hours of detention. **Sources:** [Irrawaddy and Red News Agency](#)

28 July 2022: In Pinlon suburb, Kale town, township and district, Sagaing region, the Myanmar military detained a male volunteer aid worker. **Source:** [Facebook](#)

29 July 2022: In Hlaing township, Yangon West district, Yangon region, the Myanmar military detained three volunteer aid workers from the LNGO Ah-Naing-Mae-Metta. **Source:** [Facebook](#)

30 July 2022: In Nam Par Hoke village, Hawng Par village tract, Hpakan town and township, Mohnyin district, Kachin state, an armed group in a vehicle bearing the Kachin Independence Army logo kidnapped a male Red Cross volunteer. **Sources:** [Facebook](#) and [Mizzima](#)

31 July 2022: In Lamaing town, Ye township and district, Mon state, the SAC police opened fire at a male volunteer aid worker from the LNGO Lamaing Youth Volunteers on allegations of approaching the police station at night. His body was returned on 1 August with wounds to the neck and abdomen. **Sources:** [Chindwin News Agency](#), [Democratic Voice of Burma](#) and [Mon News Agency](#)

07 August 2022: In Nawngkhio town and township, Kyaukme district, Shan state, the Myanmar military detained two LNGO volunteer aid workers, along with 18 other civilians. **Source:** [BBC Burmese](#)

09 August 2022: Around Qamishli city, Al Hasakah governorate, a Turkish drone conducted an airstrike targeting a COVID-19 hospital funded by the UN, killing four people. **Source:** [ACLED](#)¹
