Data Protection Statement

As a not for profit association, Insecurity Insight regards the lawful and fair treatment of personal information as very important to its successful operations, and to maintaining confidence between our team and all those who use and access our services.

What information will we collect, and how will we use it?

We do not collect personal data from people visiting our website, or our social media sites. If you sign up for our newsletters and updates, we will collect and securely store any personal data you choose to give us (such as your name, and email address) in accordance with the EU General Data Protection Regulation 2018. We may also use personal data to understand which of our services and products are most frequently opened or downloaded, though this data will not be shared outside of the organisation. By signing up to our mailing lists, your data is added to our MailChimp lists, an organisation which manages the technical side of our newsletters. The information securely held by MailChimp only includes your name and email address in the context of the mailing list you have chosen to subscribe to – and will not be shared by them with any other party.
