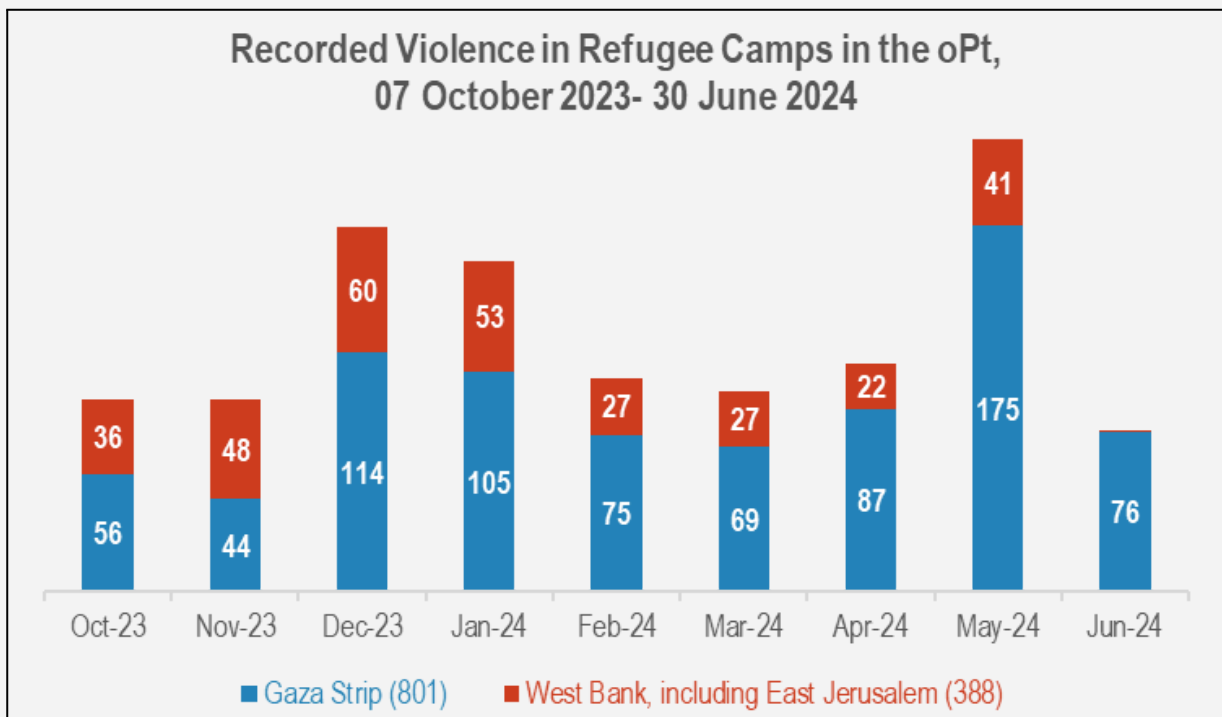


# Protection in Danger in the occupied Palestinian territory (oPt)

Incidents of threats and violence in refugee camps

July 2024

Insecurity Insight identified 1168 incidents that took place at refugee camps in the occupied Palestinian territory (oPt) between 07 October 2023 and 30 June 2024.<sup>\*</sup> In the Gaza Strip, where 836 incidents were recorded, two thirds of recorded incidents in June occurred in camps in Deir al-Balah governorate, particularly Al-Maghazi camp (13 incidents), Bureij camp (20 incidents) and Nuseirat camp (33 incidents). Compared to the previous month, incidents in Jabalia camp decreased from 65 incidents to seven incidents. In the West Bank, at least 332 incidents were recorded. Download the data [here](#).

There is a delay in reporting incidents due to our open-source verification process. Numbers may change if or when further information is made available. ## Gaza Strip

### Al-Bureij Refugee Camp

**07 July 2024:** In Block 9, Al-Bureij Refugee Camp, Deir al-Balah governorate, three people were killed and two injured when a house was hit by Israeli airstrikes. Sources: [Personal Communication](#) and [Quds News Network](#)

**08 July 2024:** In Al-Bureij Refugee Camp, Deir al-Balah governorate, one person was killed and an unspecified number injured after a house was hit by Israeli armed drones. **Source:** [Personal Communication](#)

### ***Khan Younis Refugee Camp***

**03 July 2024:** In Khan Younis Refugee Camp, Khan Yunis governorate, the vicinity of Nasser Medical Complex was hit, killing at least one Palestinian, and injuring 10 as well as damaging IDP tents at a nearby UNRWA school. **Source:** [OCHA Update 187](#)

### ***Nuseirat Refugee Camp***

**01 July 2024:** In Nuseirat Refugee Camp, Deir al-Balah governorate, an unspecified number of people were killed when a house was struck by Israeli airstrikes. **Source:** [Personal Communication](#)

### **Aqbat Jabr Refugee Camp**

**11 July 2024:** In Balata Refugee Camp, Nablus governorate, 26-year-old man was shot and injured by live bullets and a 34-year-old woman, a child, and a 23-year-old man sustained bruises from being beaten by Israeli forces during a raid on the camp. **Source:** [WAFA](#)

**16 July 2024:** In Balata Refugee Camp, Nablus governorate, a Palestinian was shot and injured and another person physically assaulted by Israeli forces. According to the Palestinian District Coordination Office (DCO), undercover Israeli forces raided the camp and besieged a house from which one Palestinian was arrested. Reportedly, Israeli forces and Palestinians exchanged fire during the operation. Medical sources reported that they transported both injured people to a nearby hospital. **Source:** [OCHA Update 195](#)



**27 July 2024:** In Balata Refugee Camp, Nablus governorate, two Palestinians, including one child, were shot and killed during an Israeli security operation on the camp. At least 36 people were injured during the operation, 26 of which were from live ammunition, four from drone strike shrapnel, and six from shrapnel where the source is yet to be confirmed. The operation lasted for about 13 hours, where exchanges of fire were reported by Palestinians, in addition to the use of drone strikes, off-shoulder missiles and live ammunition by Israeli forces. A three-story residential building was shelled by at least two off-shoulder missiles fired by Israeli forces, causing significant damage, and resulting in the displacement of two refugee families comprising five people including two girls. **27 July 2024:** In Balata Refugee Camp, Nablus governorate, a 17-year-old Palestinian was killed, and nine others were injured, including a PRCS volunteer, when Israeli forces attacked a group of individuals in the camp. Two of the injured are in critical condition. **Source:** [Wafa](#)

### ***Dheisheh Refugee Camp***

**29 July 2024:** In Dheisheh Refugee Camp, Bethlehem governorate, an unspecified number of Palestinians were arrested following an Israeli security operation inside the camp. **Source:** [Quds News Network](#)

### ***Fawwar Refugee Camp***

**26 July 2024:** In Fawwar Refugee Camp, Hebron governorate, Israeli forces stormed the camp and fired live bullets. **Source:** [Personal Communication](#)

### ***Jalazone Refugee Camp***

**18 July 2024:** In Jalazone Refugee Camp, Ramallah and al-Bireh governorate, the camp was stormed by Israeli forces who deployed snipers on rooftops and fired tear gas at civilians, causing an unspecified number of people to suffocate. **Sources:** [Quds News Network](#) and [Wafa](#)

### ***Nur Shams Refugee Camp***

**01 July 2024:** In Nur al Shams Refugee Camp, Tulkarm city and governorate, a house belonging to two siblings was demolished by Israeli forces, accompanied by military tanks and bulldozers, causing extensive damage to its infrastructure and the residents' properties. Civil defence crews were prevented by the Israeli forces from reaching the house. During the day, Israeli bulldozers destroyed the camp's infrastructure, vandalised public and private property along Nablus Street, and destroyed the main water line feeding the camp. **Source:** [Wafa](#)

**01 July 2024:** In Nur Shams Refugee Camp, Tulkarem governorate, Israeli forces killed two Palestinians and injured five others during an overnight 12-hour search-and-arrest operation that extended to Tulkarm city and Tulkarm Refugee Camp, which included the use of airstrikes. In one of the airstrikes, shrapnel hit and killed a Palestinian woman, while a 15-year-old boy (the second fatality) was reportedly killed when he was shot in the head by live ammunition fired by Israeli forces. According to the Israeli military, they had suspected the child was planting explosives. The Israeli military stated in Israeli media that one Israeli soldier was killed and another was injured by a roadside bomb planted by Palestinians. The Israeli operation included the use of four bulldozers and air drones, which damaged infrastructure and multiple road sections within and around the camp. **Source:** [OCHA Update 186](#)

**02 July 2024:** In Nur Shams Refugee Camp, Tulkarem governorate, an assessment led by the United Nations estimated that at least 200 houses were damaged during an operation carried out by Israeli forces. These included seven structures that were rendered uninhabitable due to severe damage from military bulldozers or explosions, resulting in the displacement of 11 families comprising 47 people, including 19 children. Moreover, the main road connecting Tulkarm city with Nablus and Jenin governorates also sustained extensive damage, which led to the disruption of

water supply and the temporary disruption of electricity and internet services in the camp. **Source:** [OCHA Update 186](#)

**02 July 2024:** In Nur Shams Refugee Camp, Tulkarem governorate, four Palestinians were killed in an Israeli drone strike before midnight. The Israeli military alleged the victims were planting a roadside IED when they were killed. **Sources:** [OCHA Update 186](#) and [Wafa](#)

**09 July 2024:** In Nur Shams Refugee Camp, Tulkarem governorate, sounds of fire exchanges and detonation of explosives were reported. Israeli forces besieged and raided the camp for 15 hours. Military bulldozers reportedly destroyed several road sections in and around the camp, causing significant damage to essential infrastructure and disrupting water, electricity, and internet services. External walls of homes, commercial shops and other structures also sustained damage. A UN-led inter-cluster assessment on 10 July found that 24 residential structures sustained severe damage and were rendered uninhabitable, displacing at least 36 families comprising 149 people. **Sources:** [OCHA Update 189](#), [OCHA Update 192](#), [Quds News Network](#) and [Quds news Network](#)

### ***Qalandiya Refugee Camp***

**23 July 2024:** In Qalandiya Refugee Camp, East Jerusalem, an 18-year-old Palestinian man was shot and killed by Israeli forces during a punitive demolition of a house in the camp at around midnight, which belonged to the family of a man who shot and killed two Israeli settlers in Eli settlement on 29 February 2024 and was subsequently shot and killed by a settler. Hundreds of Israeli soldiers and tens of military vehicles entered the camp to carry out the demolition that lasted seven hours. During the demolition, clashes erupted between Palestinian stone throwers and Israeli soldiers who shot live ammunition and physically assaulted residents. During the security operation, Israeli forces imposed a curfew on the camp and deployed snipers on a number of rooftops. Israeli forces shot and injured six children, and assaulted two men. A PRCS medical team was assaulted and denied access to the wounded man who later died. **Sources:** [OCHA Update 198](#) and [Quds News Network](#)

**24 July 2024:** In Qalandiya Refugee Camp, East Jerusalem, an unspecified number of Palestinians were injured by Israeli forces gunfire. **Source:** [Quds News Network](#)

**24 July 2024:** In Qalandiya Refugee Camp, East Jerusalem, a Palestinian man was reportedly killed during the punitive demolition of a house in the camp. **Source:** [OCHA Update 195](#)

**24 July 2024:** In Qalandiya Refugee Camp, East Jerusalem, a PRCS medical team was assaulted, forced to remove their protective vests, and prevented from reaching a patient by Israeli forces. **Sources:** [PRCS](#)

### ***Shu'fat Refugee Camp***

**30 July 2024:** In Shu'fat Refugee Camp, East Jerusalem, Israeli forces stormed the camp and assaulted residents at gunpoint. **Source:** [Quds News Network](#)

### ***Tulkarem Refugee Camp***

**01 July 2024:** In Tulkarem Refugee Camp, Tulkarem city and governorate, two Palestinians were killed and four injured by Israeli forces. **Source:** [Personal Communication](#)

**22 July 2024:** In Tulkarem Refugee Camp, Tulkarem city and governorate, an Israeli drone strike killed five Palestinians. Footage taken at the scene shows that an injured Palestinian was tied to the front of an Israeli army jeep as it drove through the streets. According to the Palestinian DCO, Israeli forces withheld the bodies of four of the fatalities. The operation lasted about 15 hours, where Israeli forces and Palestinians exchanged fire and Palestinians reportedly detonated explosive devices. Significant damage was reported to multiple road sections. The refugee camp and several city neighbourhoods experienced disruptions in water, electricity, and internet services. Medical sources confirmed the injuries of seven Palestinians, three by live ammunition, and four

due to missile shrapnel. The Israeli military stated that its forces had targeted Palestinian fighters. **Source:** [OCHA Update 195](#)

**23 July 2024:** In Tulkarem Refugee Camp, Tulkarem city and governorate, the camp was stormed for the second day in a row by the Israeli military. **Sources:** [Quds News Network](#), [Quds News Network](#)

**23 July 2024:** In Tulkarem Refugee Camp, Tulkarem City and governorate, PRCS medical teams managed to transport two civilians injured by live bullets. However, Israeli forces blocked PRCS crews from accessing a bombed site inside the camp, preventing them from assisting other civilians who had been killed or injured. **Source:** [PRCS](#)

**23 July 2024:** In al Hamam Neighbourhood, Tulkarem Refugee Camp, Tulkarem city and governorate, ambulance crews were prevented by the Israeli forces from reaching the killed and injured civilians in the neighbourhood. **Source:** [WAFA](#)
