

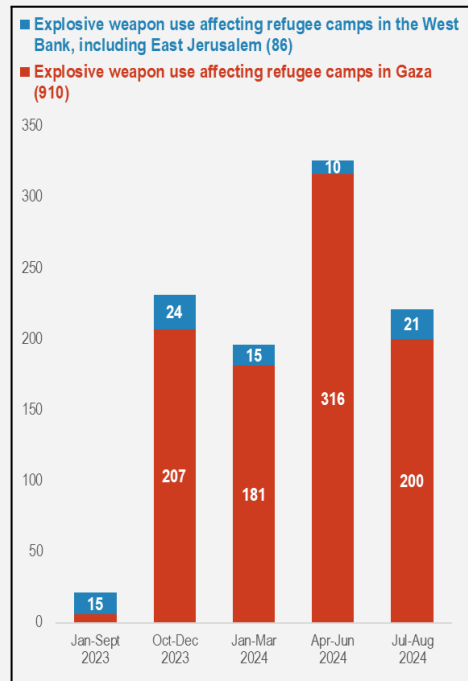
Protection in Danger in the occupied Palestinian territory (oPt)

Incidents of threats and violence in refugee camps

September
2024

Insecurity Insight has identified 1514 incidents that took place at official UNRWA refugee camps in the occupied Palestinian territory (oPt) between 07 October 2023 and 31 August 2024. In these incidents, nearly 5000 Palestinians, including children, have been killed and thousands more injured. Almost all 1514 incidents have been attributed to the Israeli Defence Forces and almost two-thirds involved the use of explosive weapons, in particular Israeli airstrikes which have occurred on a near-daily basis in Gaza.

High incident numbers of explosive weapons impacting refugee camps have been recorded in Gaza's northern Jabalia Refugee Camp, the largest camp in the strip, where [thousands of people](#) are currently trapped. The camp has been under siege since October 6. In this military offensive, Israeli airstrikes have killed the UNRWA head of operations and a food distribution centre has been hit, killing at least 10 Palestinians queuing for flour. Palestinians report being trapped inside the camp after Israeli forces entered [without prior warning](#), blocked all camp exits, and used drones to fire on anyone attempting to leave. Rescuers have been unable to reach the bodies of those killed, and ambulances and civil defence teams unable to reach people in need. Al-Bureij Refugee Camp

Al-Arroub Camp

27 September 2024: In al-Arroub Camp, Hebron governorate, two Palestinians were shot and injured as they were driving on a motorcycle past the camp by Israeli forces who were stationed at the entrance's watchtower. **Source:** [Wafa](#)

28 September 2024: In al-Arroub Camp, Hebron governorate, a woman was shot and injured during an Israeli raid on the camp. The Israeli forces used live ammunition, rubber-coated steel bullets, and stun grenades against residents. **Source:** [Wafa](#)

Balata Refugee Camp

15 September 2024: In Balata Refugee Camp, Nablus city and governorate, a home was raided by Israeli forces. **Source:** [Quds News Network](#)

29 September 2024: In Balata Refugee Camp, Nablus city and governorate, an unspecified number of houses were damaged during an Israeli military operation. **Source:** [Quds News Network](#)

01 October 2024: In Balata Refugee Camp, Nablus city and governorate, a Palestinian man was killed by Israeli forces during an eight-hour operation in the camp. **Source:** [OCHA Update 225](#)

Dheisheh Refugee Camp

16 September 2024: In Dheisheh Refugee Camp, Bethlehem governorate, a Palestinian man was injured by a live bullet and three others were detained during an Israeli raid. Israeli forces also fired sound bombs and tear gas. **Sources:** [Quds News Network](#) and [Wafa](#)

Ein Beit al Mai Refugee Camp

26 September 2024: In Ein Beit al Mai Refugee Camp, Nablus governorate, a man was shot by Israeli forces during an undercover arrest operation. He was reported dead later during the day. **Source:** [OCHA Update 225](#)

Far'a Refugee Camp

05 September 2024: In Far'a Refugee Camp, Tubas governorate, five Palestinians were killed and three injured in an Israeli airstrike. **Source:** [OCHA Update 216](#)

05 September 2024: In Abu Zeina neighbourhood, Far'a Refugee Camp, Tubas governorate, a 16-year-old Palestinian boy was shot and killed and another person injured during a nighttime military operation by Israeli forces positioned around the camp. According to local sources, the boy

was outside the camp and attempting to return home when he was shot three times in the leg. Israeli forces denied medical teams from assisting the injured boy and then shot him at point-blank range in the neck, killing him. PRCS reported that after the boy was killed, an Israeli bulldozer dragged his body to another location within the camp, resulting in the mutilation of his body. According to UNRWA, an exchange of fire between Israeli forces and Palestinians, and the use of explosive devices by the latter was reported. **Sources:** [DCI Palestine](#) and [OCHA Update 216](#)

11 September 2024: In Far'a Refugee Camp, Tubas governorate, Israeli forces imposed a curfew, closed city entrances and carried out an airstrike, resulting in five Palestinian fatalities. Six Palestinians, including a child were shot and injured during the military operation. **Source:** [OCHA Update 216](#)

12 September 2024: In Far'a Refugee Camp, Tubas governorate, a man was killed when Israeli forces raided the camp at around midnight. The IDF also deployed snipers and infantry soldiers in the camp, and raided several homes, while bulldozers caused destruction and damage to the infrastructure in the camp. **Source:** [Wafa](#)

Fawwar Refugee Camp

16 September 2024: At the entrance of Fawwar Refugee Camp, Hebron governorate, a young man was injured and several others suffered from suffocation when Israeli forces fired tear gas at people. **Sources:** [Quds News Network](#) and [Wafa](#)

18 September 2024: In Fawwar Refugee Camp, Hebron governorate, around 50 Palestinians were detained at the entrance of the camp during an Israeli military operation. During interrogations, some of the detainees were reportedly assaulted. 28 of the 50 were arrested by Israeli forces with seven released the next day, showing signs of severe mistreatment. They were reportedly kept handcuffed and blindfolded, and were denied food and water during their detention. Soldiers also used a hammer to strike them and attempted to extract the teeth of one of the seven detainees. During the operation, they instituted a curfew, ordering 13,000 people to stay home. physically assaulted and injured 12 Palestinians, including seven women, while searching 150 homes. During the raid, Israeli forces reportedly stole money and food supplies from homes and shops, and caused material damage to the homes. At least 40 houses had furniture and other belongings damaged, and 36 households reported damages to their water tanks. **Sources:** [Ma'an News](#), [OCHA Update 222](#) and [Wafa](#)

18 September 2024: In Fawwar Refugee Camp, Hebron governorate, an unspecified number of homes were raided, stormed and searched in a military operation by Israeli forces. **Source:** [Quds News Network](#)

18 September 2024: In Fawwar Refugee Camp, Hebron governorate, a home and shop were raided by Israeli forces. **Source:** [Quds News Network](#)

24 September 2024: In Fawwar Refugee Camp, Hebron governorate, a Palestinian man was shot and killed by Israeli forces during clashes that erupted during an Israeli military operation. Another Palestinian was injured by live ammunition. **Source:** [OCHA Update 222](#)

24 September 2024: In Fawwar Refugee Camp, Hebron governorate, a 28-year-old Palestinian man was shot and killed during a search-and-arrest operation by Israeli forces. **Source:** [OCHA Update 225](#)

Jalazoun Refugee Camp

02 September 2024: In Jalazoun Refugee Camp, Ramallah and al-Bireh governorate, a Palestinian young man was assaulted and detained from his home by Israeli forces. **Source:** [Quds News Network](#)

04 September 2024: In Jalazoun Refugee Camp, Ramallah and al-Bireh governorate, a man was injured and at least 16 others were detained during an Israeli raid on the camp. During the raid, Israeli forces closed off all entrances to the camp and fired live bullets, tear gas and sound bombs during clashes with residents. **Source:** [WAFA](#)

22 September 2024: In Jalazon Refugee Camp, Ramallah city and governorate, numerous students, boys and girls at a UNRWA school suffered from gas inhalation after Israeli forces fired tear gas near the school. **Source:** [WAFA](#)

Jenin Refugee Camp

01 September 2024: In Jenin Refugee Camp, Jenin city and governorate, an unspecified number of Palestinian youths were shot by Israeli forces. **Source:** [Quds News Network](#)

01 September 2024: In Jenin Refugee Camp, Jenin city and governorate, two buildings were blown up by Israeli forces. **Sources:** [Quds News Network](#), [Quds News Network](#)

01 September 2024: In Jenin Refugee Camp, Jenin city and governorate, families were forced out of their home as Israeli forces attacked the camp for the fifth day in a row. **Sources:** [Quds News Network](#), [Quds News Network](#) and [WAFA](#)

01 September 2024: In Jenin Refugee Camp, Jenin governorate, paramedics were prevented from reaching an elderly Palestinian who had been shot and run over by Israeli forces. **Source:** [Quds News Network](#)

01 September 2024: In Jenin Refugee Camp, Jenin governorate, a house was blown up by Israeli forces. **Source:** [BBC](#)

04 September 2024: In Jenin Refugee Camp, Jenin city and governorate, a house was burned by Israeli forces. **Source:** [WAFA](#)

05 September 2024: In Jorat al Dahab and al Damaj neighbourhoods, Jenin Refugee Camp, Jenin city and governorate, six families were forced to evacuate their homes and transported to villages west of Jenin by ambulances vehicles. **Source:** [WAFA](#)

As reported on 11 September 2024: In Kafr Dan, Jenin Refugee Camp and the eastern side of Jenin city, Jenin governorate, a ten-day operation by Israeli forces resulted in 19 Palestinian fatalities, 58 injuries, and at least 44 Palestinians arrested, along with significant damage to civilian infrastructure, including roads, residential, and livelihood shelters. Families, including children, were also displaced and thousands of people were deprived of water due to the destruction of public infrastructure inside the camp. **Sources:** [Quds News Network](#) and [OCHA Update 216](#)

25 September 2024: In Jenin Refugee Camp, Jenin city and governorate, a house was demolished by Israeli forces using explosives. **Source:** [Arab48](#)

Nur Shams Refugee Camp

10 September 2024: In Nur Shams Refugee Camp, Tulkarm governorate, Israeli forces surrounded the main hospital during a security raid on the camp. **Source:** [OCHA Update 219](#)

As reported on 11 September 2024: In Nur Shams Refugee Camp, Tulkarm governorate, medical teams were unable to reach casualties. **Source:** [OCHA Update 216](#)

As reported on 11 September 2024: In Tulkarm and Nur Shams Refugee Camps, Tulkarem governorate, seven Palestinian were killed, 14 injured, and extensive damage to infrastructure and residential shelters during a ten-day military operation by Israeli forces. **Sources:** [Quds News Network](#) and [OCHA Update 216](#)

12 September 2024: In Nur Shams Refugee Camp, Tulkarem governorate, the entrance to the camp was destroyed by two Israeli bulldozers. The bulldozers moved through the camp, destroying infrastructure and damaging communication and internet networks, which caused an outage in internet services in the entire camp. **Source:** [WAFA](#)

Qalandiya Refugee Camp

20 September 2024: In Qalqilya Refugee Camp, Jerusalem, Israeli forces shot and killed a Palestinian man. According to local sources and video footage, they stationed themselves at the entrance of the camp and opened fire at a group of Palestinians gathered at a local coffee shop. **Source:** [OCHA Update 222](#)

Shu'fat Refugee Camp

03 September 2024: In Shu'fat Refugee Camp, East Jerusalem, one person was injured and another detained during an Israeli military operation. Shops were forcefully entered, residents assaulted and rubber-coated steel bullets fired as well as tear gas and concussion grenades. **Source:** [WAFA](#)

18 September 2024: In Shu'fat Refugee Camp, East Jerusalem, a 16-year old boy was shot and killed by Israeli forces, alleging that he was shooting fireworks at them, while another was wounded during an Israeli forces military operation. The raid involved live fire directed at residents and the detention of five youths, including a journalist. **Sources:** [OCHA Update 222](#) and [WAFA](#)

25 September 2024: In Shu'fat Refugee Camp, East Jerusalem, Palestinians were attacked by Israeli police forces who fired bullets and tear gas canisters at them and their homes. **Source:** [Al Ghad](#)

30 September 2024: In Shu'fat Refugee Camp, East Jerusalem, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint to the camp restricting the movement of residents inside the camp, including students heading to school. **Source:** [Quds News Network](#)

Tulkarem Refugee Camp

02 September 2024: In Tulkarem Refugee Camp, Tulkarem governorate, a 14-year-old boy was shot and killed and six Palestinians injured, including a 12-year-old girl by Israeli forces. An airstrike injured three, including a female paramedic. Throughout the camp, Palestinians shot and deployed explosive devices against Israeli forces, who fired live ammunition at Palestinians. Additionally, medical resources reported that one Palestinian was treated for wounds sustained from physical assault. **Sources:** [OCHA Update 213](#) and [WAFA](#)

02 September 2024: In Tulkarem Refugee Camp, Tulkarem governorate, streets and infrastructure were destroyed by Israeli bulldozers. **Source:** [Quds News Network](#)

04 September 2024: In Tulkarem Refugee Camp, Tulkarem governorate, several Palestinian homes were demolished and set on fire by Israeli forces. **Source:** [WAFA](#)

05 September 2024: In Al-Madares neighbourhood, Tulkarem Refugee Camp, Tulkarem governorate, residents suffered from smoke inhalation after Israeli forces used explosives to denote a home. **Source:** [WAFA](#)

10 September 2024: In Tulkarem Refugee Camp, Tulkarem governorate, Israeli forces stormed the camp with bulldozers and military vehicles. They surrounded the camp, blocking every entrance with military vehicles and deploying snipers on several buildings. At least 10 Palestinians were injured by live bullets, tear gas and sound bombs. Israeli forces also used loudspeakers to order shops to close and order people to leave the markets. At least one house was damaged with unspecified explosives during the operation. This operation occurred less than a week after a

10 September 2024: In Tulkarem Refugee Camp, Tulkarem governorate, a PRCS volunteer was hit by an Israeli live bullet while providing first aid to an injured person in the camp. **Source:** [PRCS](#)

10 September 2024: In Tulkarem Refugee Camp, Tulkarem governorate, two PRCS EMTs were arrested, later released, following the storming of the Tulkarem Emergency Centre by Israeli forces. The EMT crews were prevented from providing any medical services in the governorate. **Source:** [PRCS](#)

10 September 2024: In Tulkarem Refugee Camp, Tulkarem governorate, at least 24 people, including four school students, were unable to leave the UNRWA school and clinic for over five hours, as Israeli forces operated in the area, before they were evacuated. **Source:** [OCHA Update 219](#)

11 September 2024: In Tulkarem Refugee Camp, Tulkarem governorate, three bulletproof vests of PRCS were confiscated by Israeli forces. These vests belong to three PRCS EMTs who were detained in the camp and released later in the same day. **Sources:** [PRCS](#) and [Quds News Network](#)

11 September 2024: In Tulkarem Refugee Camp, Tulkarem governorate, a PRCS Emergency medical service team was detained by Israeli forces and contact with them was lost for approximately two hours. The team was en route to transport a patient after prior coordination with Israeli forces through the international committee of the red cross. **Source:** [PRCS](#)

12 September 2024: In Tulkarem Refugee Camp, Tulkarem governorate, three young men were detained by Israeli forces during the third consecutive day of an Israeli military raid. Israeli forces positioned themselves at the camp's entrances, deployed infantry throughout the streets, placed snipers in tall buildings, and turned several houses into military barracks after forcibly evicting the residents. **Source:** [WAFA](#)
