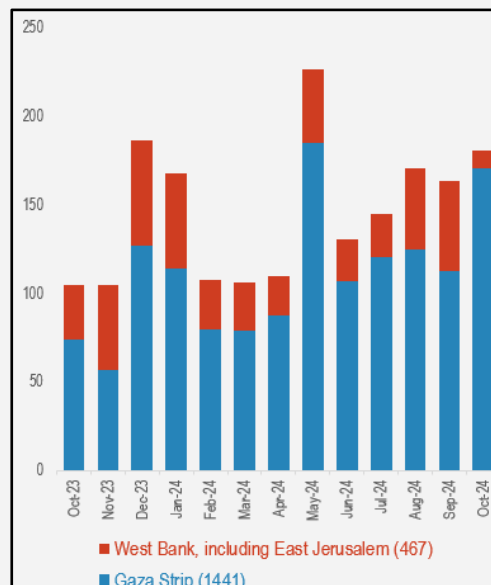

Insecurity Insight identified 1908 incidents that took place at refugee or makeshift camps in the occupied Palestinian territory (oPt) between 07 October 2023 and 30 November 2024. Almost all 1908 incidents have been attributed to the Israeli Defence Forces. In the Gaza Strip where 1441 incidents were recorded, most took place in Nuseirat Refugee Camp (379) and Jabalia Refugee Camp (362). Homes and other civilian infrastructure were damaged and destroyed and residents killed and injured by explosive weapons use. At least 467 incidents took place in the West Bank, with high numbers recorded in Jenin Refugee Camp (93). Most of these incidents involved military raids, during which camp residents were arrested and civilian infrastructure bulldozed.

Safety, security and access incidents

Incidents of threats and violence in refugee and IDP settings.

Africa

Democratic Republic of the Congo

02 December 2024: In Bulengo IDP Camp, Lac-Vert, Goma, North Kivu, province five people were injured and belongings looted when an unidentified armed group attacked the camp. **Source:** [Kivu morning post](#)

Between the night of 23 and 24 December 2024: In Rego IDP camp, Lac Vert neighbourhood, Goma city, North Kivu province, a father and his child were injured by unidentified armed men. **Source:** [Bunia Actualite](#)

27 December 2024: In Djangi site in Drodro IDP camp, Bahema Nord chiefdom, Djugu territory, Ituri province, two houses were set on fire when armed men attacked the camp between 22:00-23:00 hrs. The attack was then repelled by MONUSCO peacekeepers. **Source:** [Bunia Actualite](#)

South Sudan

10 December 2024: In Tambura town, Western Equatoria, an unidentified armed group killed a civilian and injured a woman and child at an IDP camp in St. Mary Help of Christians Catholic Parish. **Sources:** [Crux](#), [Crux I](#) and [Ground news](#)

- 01 December 2024:** In Abu Shouk IDP Camp, El Fasher city, North Darfur state, Nevasha market was shelled by RSF backed by an unspecified militia. **Source:** [ACLED](#)¹
- 01 December 2024:** In Zamzam IDP Camp, El Fasher city, North Darfur state, an unspecified number of people were killed and injured when Darfur Arab militia shelled the camp. **Sources:** [Al Jazeera](#), [Bahrain News App](#), [Misr News](#), [Medameek](#), [Khaleej Topics](#) and [Shorouk News](#)
- Between 01-02 December 2024:** In Zamzam IDP Camp, El Fasher city, North Darfur state, NGOs were forced to suspend their activities and the hospital was evacuated due to the danger and risks it posed. **Source:** [Sudan Violations](#)
- 02 December 2024:** In Abu Shouk IDP Camp, El Fasher city, North Darfur state, at least one person was killed and several injured when Darfur Arab militia shelled artillery on the camp. **Source:** [ACLED](#)¹
- 02 December 2024:** In Zamzam IDP Camp, El Fasher city, North Darfur state, eight people were killed and 13 were wounded when the RSF shelled the camp. **Source:** [Sudan Tribune](#)

- 05 December 2024:** In Abu Shouk IDP Camp, El Fasher city, North Darfur state, one person was killed in an artillery shelling by an unidentified armed group. **Source:** [ACLED](#)¹
- Between 06-07 December 2024:** In Zamzam IDP camp, El Fasher city, North Darfur state, RSF shelling displaced 739 households from the camp. **Sources:** [Personal Communication](#), [Relief Web](#) and [Salam Media](#)
- 08 December 2024:** In Kebkabiya district, North Darfur state, 27 people were killed when SAF airstrikes hit an IDP shelter. **Source:** [Fenix Insight](#)
- 10 December 2024:** In Zamzam IDP Camp, El Fasher city, North Darfur state, at least nine people, including children, were killed and an unspecified number injured by RSF artillery shelling. **Sources:** [Sudan Tribune](#), [Personal Communication I](#) and [Personal Communication II](#)
- 11 December 2024:** In Zamzam Refugee Camp, El Fasher City, North Darfur state, 15 people including five children, were killed and more than 64 others were wounded by RSF shelling. **Source:** [Sudan Tribune](#), [Personal Communication I](#) and [Personal Communication II](#)
- 12 December 2024:** In Abu Shouk IDP Camp, Al Fasher city, North Darfur, an unspecified number of IDPs were injured when a Darfur Arab militia shelled artillery at the camp. **Source:** [ACLED](#)¹
- 12 December 2024:** In El Fasher city, North Darfur, state, an unspecified number of people were injured when RSF artillery struck a shelter centre. **Source:** [Personal Communication](#)
- 14 December 2024:** In Shalla IDP camp, Al Fasher city, North Darfur state, seven people, including four children, were killed and 11 others injured when the RSF shelled the camp. **Source:** [Sudan Doctors News](#)

17 December 2024: In Nyala city, South Darfur state, two people were killed and 21 injured following airstrikes on Nyala Secondary School sheltering IDPs. Some people were trapped under the rubble. **Source:** [Radio Dabanga](#)

19 December 2024: In Nyala city, South Darfur state, nine people were killed and over 15 injured when the Sudanese Air Force struck the Nyala Boys' Secondary School sheltering IDPs. **Sources:** [DNHR](#) and [Personnel Communication](#)

26 December 2024: In Abu Shouk IDP Camp, El Fasher city, North Darfur state, three people were killed and an unspecified number injured in a RSF airstrike. **Source:** [Sudan Tribune](#)

26 December 2024: In Shala IDP Camp, El Fasher city, North Darfur state, 10 people were killed and an unspecified number injured in a RSF missile strike. **Source:** [Sudan Violations](#)

28 December 2024: In El Fashir city, North Darfur state, an unspecified number of persons were killed and 17 injured when Qoz Bina school sheltering IDPs was hit by a RSF drone strike. **Source:** [JubraKa News](#)

28 December 2024: In Block 15, Abu Shouk Camp, Al Fasher city, North Darfur state, a man was killed and an unspecified number of people injured when the RSF bombed the IRC health centre. **Source:** [Darfur Victims Support](#)

31 December 2024: In Abu Jarboun IDP Camp, El Fasher city, North Darfur state, 10 people were killed and 18 injured following an RSF airstrike. **Source:** [Personal Communication](#)

Myanmar

03 December 2024: In Hseng Hkun village, Pekon township, Taunggyi district, Shan-South state, Myanmar military dropped 40 bombs on the village, damaging nearby IDP camps at around 03:00 hrs. **Source:** [ACLED](#)¹

04 December 2024: In Inn Lar Kwin IDP Camp, Moe Bye town, Pekon township, Taungoo district, Shan-South state, three IDPs were killed, including a child, and three children injured in a Myanmar military drone strike at around 15:00 hrs. **Source:** [BNI Online](#)

Middle East and North Africa

Lebanon

02 December 2024: In Ain al-Hilweh Refugee Camp, South governorate, Saida City, three people including a child were killed in armed clashes. **Sources:** [L'Orient Today](#) and [L'Orient Today I](#)

Syrian Arab Republic

01 December 2024: In an unspecified IDP camp near Harbanoush village, Idlib governorate, five Russian airstrikes hit the camp. **Sources:** [BBC](#) and [SOHR](#)

02 December 2024: In an unspecified IDP camp, Ma'arrat Misrin city, Idlib governorate, an unspecified number of people were killed and injured in Russian and Syrian regime airstrikes. **Source:** [ACLED](#)¹

02 December 2024: In Talhadiyah IDP Camp, Haranbush village, Idlib countryside, seven people, including five childrens were killed and an unspecified number of others injured in wounded Russian and Syrian regime airstrikes. **Sources:** [AA](#) and [Syrian Network](#)

Yemen

20 December 2024: In Markouda IDP Camp, Al Duraihimi district, Al Hudaydah governorate, Tihama region, hooded gunmen stormed the camp and kidnapped a 40-year-old woman forcing her on a military vehicle taking her to an unknown location. **Source:** [Khabar News Agency](#)
