

# Attacks on Health Care in the occupied Palestinian territory

11-24 June 2025



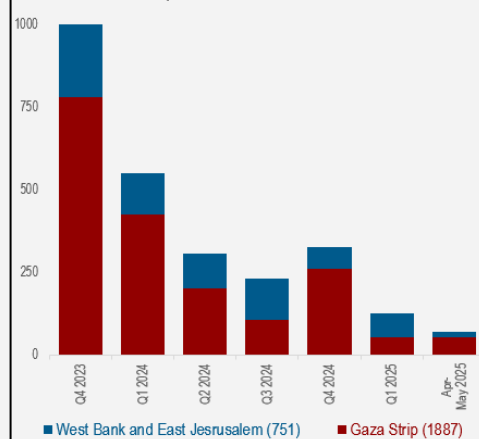
Insecurity Insight identified 2698 incidents of violence against or obstruction of access to health care in the occupied Palestinian territory between 07 October 2023 and 27 May 2025.<sup>1</sup> In the Gaza Strip, where 1887 incidents were recorded, health facilities were damaged 371 times, 655 health workers were killed and 355 arrested.<sup>2</sup>

In the West Bank and East Jerusalem, where 751 incidents were recorded, 12 health workers were killed and 160 arrested. Ambulances and health workers were prevented from providing vital medical care to people in need over 470 times.

## Gaza Strip

**13 June 2025:** In Khan Yunis city and governorate, Nasser Medical Complex was hit by an Israeli forces airstrike, killing and injuring an unspecified number of people. **Source:** [The New Arab](#)

**14 June 2025:** In Khan Yunis city and governorate, the vicinity of Nasser Hospital was hit by Israeli forces gunfire and artillery shelling. **Sources:** [Personal Communication](#) and [Quds News Network](#)

**16 June 2025:** In al Malawsi area, Rafah governorate, the Red Cross Field Hospital was fired at by Israeli forces vehicles. **Source:** [Wafa](#)

**17 June 2025:** In al Mawasi area, Khan Yunis governorate, an Anera psychological support coordinator and his two children aged 5 and 7, were killed by an Israeli drone strike on his tent. His wife and two other children aged 9 and 13 were severely wounded. **Sources:** [Anera](#) and [Personal Communication](#)

**20 June 2025:** In Gaza city and governorate, the vicinity of the Gaza Eye Hospital was struck by an Israeli forces airstrike, killing three people and injuring an unspecified number of others. **Source:** [WAFA](#)

**24 June 2025:** In Gaza city and governorate, the Al Ahli Baptist Hospital, run by Episcopal Church of Jerusalem, was opened fire at by Israeli forces drones. **Source:** [Quds News Network](#)

## West Bank and East Jerusalem

*No incidents identified during the reporting period.*

### Other resources

Since October 2023, West Bank Palestinian farmers have been repeatedly attacked, intimidated and threatened. These acts go beyond the resulting harm to the affected individuals and adversely affect the food security of the wider community. Insecurity Insight's [documentation](#) shows that the following incidents occurred in the West Bank between 7 October 2023 and 31 December 2024:

- Among others, the incidents involved Israeli settlers and/or Israeli security forces using firearms to “scare” or “harass” farmers in attempts to force them to leave their land, and farmers being physically assaulted and attacked.
- More than a third of the incidents occurred in the context of the olive harvest, and these incidents increased dramatically in October 2024 during the olive harvest season. Read the [full report](#).



The Safeguarding Health in Conflict Coalition (SHCC) identified **1,361 incidents of violence against or obstruction of health care in the occupied Palestinian territory (oPt) in 2024**, compared to 1,170 in 2023. In the Gaza Strip, where 940 incidents were recorded, there was a 22% increase from 2023, when 770 incidents were recorded. In these incidents, at least 218 health workers were killed and 192 arrested. Health facilities were damaged or destroyed at least 192 times and raided or occupied multiple times. In the West Bank and East Jerusalem, the recorded incidents doubled to 418 incidents in 2024, compared to 208 in 2023. In these incidents, 80 health workers were arrested, 75 injured and eight killed, and health facilities were damaged or destroyed at least 13 times and raided 21 times. Access to health care was blocked or delayed at least 272 times, which left patients without access to medical treatment, proving fatal in some circumstances. <sup>2</sup> 655 is based on the number of health workers killed where location and date has been identified. Other sources have reported **1,173 workers killed**. Insecurity Insight carries out cross-checking of individual events and names and does not re-report aggregate figures. The work of collating a complete list of health workers killed based on information provided in different formats by different organisations is ongoing. This cross-checking process is complex to avoid double counting the same individuals in cases when sources report different victim information about the same individual. The lack of a consistent standard in transcribing Arab names into Latin script based languages complicates the matching process. The total number of health workers killed is believed to be higher than the current verified number and we continue to backdate information.
