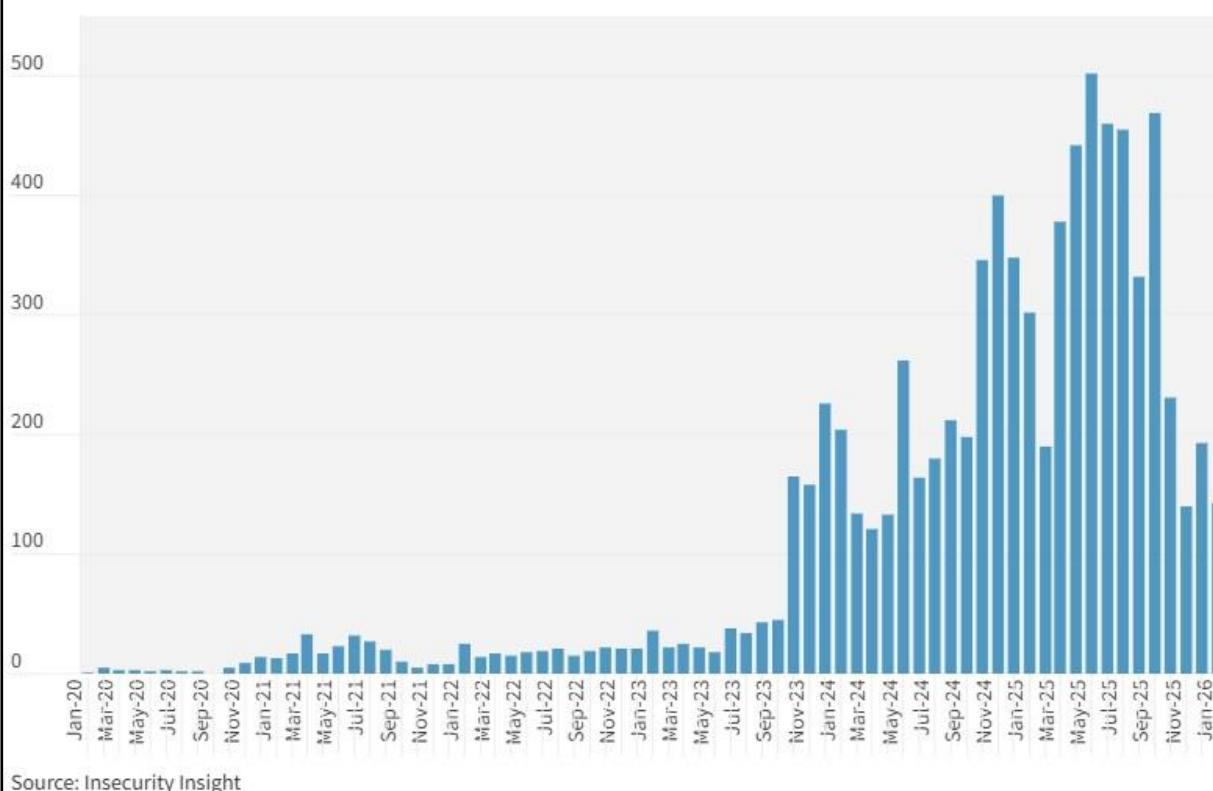


Insecurity Insight's Protection in Danger open-source monitoring identified 8,260 incidents of threats and violence that took place at IDP/refugee camps, including temporary shelters between 01 January 2020 and January 2026. In these incidents, camps were damaged or destroyed on 4,827 occasions, 16,205 camp residents were killed, 13,064 injured, 471 kidnapped and 5,039 arrested. Documented Protection in Danger incidents, January 2020- January 2026

Since January 2020, 8,260 incidents were documented. 4,827 incidents reported damage or destruction to IDP/refugee camps, including temporary shelter. In addition, 16,205 camp residents were killed, 13,064 injured, 471 kidnapped and 5,039 arrested.



Developments in February 2026

Gaza: Throughout February, Jabalia IDP Camp in North Gaza was repeatedly attacked by Israeli forces across multiple days. Incidents included tank shelling, airstrikes, drone fire, and controlled demolitions, resulting in civilian harm, including killings and injuries to children, and widespread destruction of homes and civilian infrastructure. UNRWA school facilities within the camp were demolished, residential areas and tents sheltering internally displaced persons were struck with explosive weapons, causing multiple killings. The presence of unexploded ordnance further endangered people living inside the camp. See *Gaza* section below for more details.

Tanzania: In mid-February, Nduta Refugee Camp in Kigoma region saw a deterioration in security, with at least five Burundian refugees abducted in separate incidents by unidentified masked perpetrators. These events occurred amid a broader pattern of nighttime attacks, intimidation, threats of mass deportation, and reports of physical and sexual violence. Safety, security and access incidents

Incidents of threats and violence in refugee and IDP settings.

Africa

Democratic Republic of the Congo

10 February 2025: In Djaba IDP camp, Djugu territory, Ituri province, the camp was attacked by Cooperative for the Development of the Congo (CODECO) militiamen who burned and looted an unspecified number of homes and killing around 55 people. **Source:** [Radio Okapi](#)

13 February 2026: In Tuungane IDP Camp, near Kpangba area, Djugu territory, Ituri province, the camp was hit by a shell fired by suspected CRP militiamen. **Source:** [Radio Okapi](#)

Sudan

16 February 2026: In El Sunut locality, West Kordofan state, an IDP shelter was bombed by a SAF drone, killing 26 people, including five women and 15 children, and injuring 15 others. **Sources:** [Dabanga Sudan](#), [Darfur Victims Support Organization](#), [Sudan War Monitor](#) and [TRT World](#)

Tanzania

Around 17 February 2026: In Nduta Camp, Kasulu city, Kigoma region, four Burundian refugees were abducted by unidentified masked perpetrators on different dates, amid a series of nighttime attacks, growing intimidation, and threats of mass deportations. An unspecified number of refugees also reported physical and sexual violence. **Source:** [SOS Medias Burundi](#)

18 February 2026: In Nduta Camp, Kasulu city, Kigoma region, a Burundian refugee was abducted by unidentified masked perpetrators amid a series of nighttime attacks, growing intimidation, and threats of mass deportations. **Source:** [SOS Medias Burundi](#)

Asia

Afghanistan

28 February 2026: In Takhta Pul district, Kandahar province, a newly built refugee camp was hit by an airstrike, killing three workers and injuring seven. **Source:** [Radio Killid](#)

Indonesia

Between 31 January to 06 February 2026: In a makeshift camp, Puncak regency, Central Papua province, the camp was bombed by Indonesian military drones, killing and injuring an unspecified number of people. **Sources:** [ACLEDD](#)¹ and [United Liberation Movement for West Papua](#)

Myanmar

14 February 2026: In Loikaw city, township and district, Kayah state, an IDP camp was hit by a Myanmar military drone at around 1045hrs, injuring two children, aged 3 and 5. **Source:** [Khit Thit Media](#)

24 February 2026: In Kyaukphyu township, Rakhine state, an IDP camp was hit by two Myanmar military suicide drone, injuring two men. **Source:** [Arakan Bay News](#)

Middle East and North Africa

Lebanon

20 February 2026: In Ain al-Hilweh Refugee Camp, South governorate, a food distribution kitchen was struck by an Israeli drone, killing two people and injuring an unspecified number of others. **Sources:** [Quds News Network](#), [Quds News Network I](#) and [Raya](#)

Jabalia Refugee Camp

01 February 2026: In Jabalia Refugee Camp, North Gaza governorate, the eastern areas of the camp were fired at by Israeli tanks. **Source:** [Quds News Network](#)

02 February 2026: Near the Square of the Six Martyrs, Jabalia Refugee Camp, North Gaza governorate, a Palestinian youth was injured by Israeli gunfire. **Source:** [Quds News Network](#)

02 February 2026: In Jabalia Refugee Camp, North Gaza governorate, the camp was hit by an Israeli airstrike in the morning, killing a person. **Source:** [Quds News Network](#)

05 February 2026: In the east of Jabalia Refugee Camp, North Gaza governorate, an unspecified number of buildings were blown up and destroyed by Israeli detonations. **Source:** [Quds News Network](#)

05 February 2026: In Jabalia Refugee Camp, North Gaza governorate, the UNRWA Jabalya Preparatory Boys' School was demolished by Israeli forces. **Sources:** [OCHA](#) and [United Nations](#)

11 February 2026: In Jabalia Refugee Camp, North Gaza governorate, the camp was entered by Israeli vehicles and bulldozers, which destroyed the remains of UNRWA schools while opening intense fire. **Source:** [Quds News Network](#)

15 February 2026: In Jabalia Refugee Camp, North Gaza governorate, homes were destroyed by Israeli forces using an explosive-laden robot. **Source:** [Quds News Network](#)

15 February 2026: In Jabalia Refugee Camp, North Gaza governorate, a tent sheltering IDPs was hit by an Israeli airstrike, killing at least three people and injuring an unspecified number of others. **Sources:** [Quds News Network](#) and [Wafa](#)

15 February 2026: In Jabalia Refugee Camp, North Gaza governorate, a flare was fired over the camp by Israeli forces. **Source:** [Quds News Network](#)

15 February 2026: In al-Falujaa area, Jabalia Refugee Camp, North Gaza governorate, an Israeli aerial missile killed four people and injured an unspecified number of others. **Sources:** [Asharq Al-Awsat](#), [Quds News Network](#), [Quds News Network](#) and [Wafa](#)

16 February 2026: In Jabalia Refugee Camp, North Gaza governorate, the camp was fired upon by Israeli tanks. **Source:** [Quds News Network](#)

The Americas

Haiti

As reported on 14 February 2026: In Port-au-Prince city, West department, around ten cases of sexual exploitation in various IDP camps, in exchange for humanitarian aid, were reported, according to the Children's Protection Committee (KPTSL) report. **Source:** [Haiti Info Proj](#)
