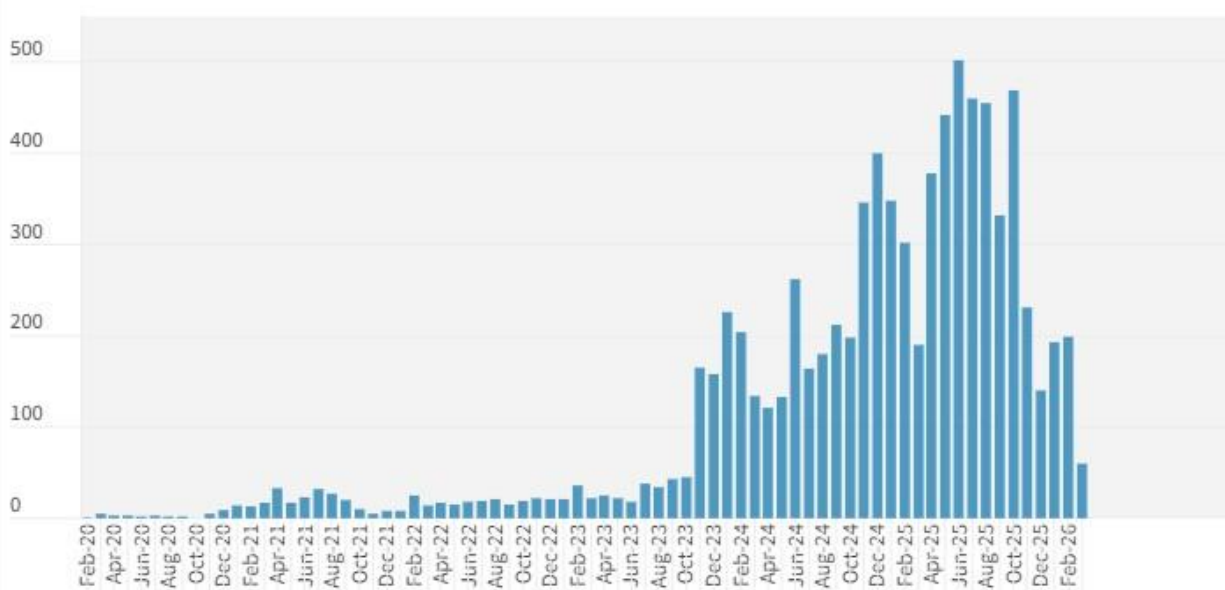


Insecurity Insight's Protection in Danger open-source monitoring identified 8,385 incidents of threats and violence that took place at IDP/refugee camps, including temporary/makeshift shelters between 01 January 2020 and February 2026. In these incidents, camps were damaged or destroyed on 5,058 occasions, 16,279 camp residents were killed, 13,069 injured, 472 kidnapped and 5,101 arrested. Documented Protection in Danger incidents, January 2020 - February 2026

Since January 2020, 8,385 incidents were documented. 5,058 incidents reported damage or destruction to IDP/refugee camps, including temporary/makeshift shelters. In addition, 16,279 camp residents were killed, 13,069 injured, 472 kidnapped and 5,101 arrested.

Developments in March 2026

Lebanon: In March, Israeli actions in Palestinian refugee camps across Lebanon led to widespread displacement, casualties, and increased insecurity. Mass forced evacuation orders in Beirut (4-5 March) and later warnings around Tyre (17 March) displaced many residents. Israeli airstrikes on Ain al-Hilweh Refugee Camp (8 March) and Mieh Mieh Refugee Camp (24 March), killed and injured residents, further worsening the humanitarian situation.

Gaza: Throughout March, repeated Israeli strikes and gunfire hit makeshift camps for IDPs across Gaza, causing widespread civilian harm and worsening humanitarian conditions. Israeli airstrikes, drone attacks, and shelling hit tents throughout the month, killing civilians - including children, a journalist, and a paramedic - and injuring many others. Israeli forces also fired on displacement camps multiple times, killing and injuring additional residents. Additional incidents worsened conditions in the camps: an Israeli airstrike-induced fire spread through tents in Gaza city (11 March), while structural collapses destroyed shelters and killed and injured residents, further deepening the humanitarian crisis.

Safety, security and access incidents

Incidents of threats and violence in refugee and IDP settings.

Africa

Democratic Republic of the Congo

09 March 2026: In Djugu territory, Ituri province, the Plaine Savo displacement site was infiltrated by militiamen from the armed group Convention for the Popular Revolution (CRP), who pushed the Armed Forces of the Democratic Republic of the Congo (FARDC) towards the outskirts of the area. The heavy exchange of gunfire caused panic among the displaced, while community leaders warned that access to health care and food had been cut off, raising fears of increased preventable deaths from disease and malnutrition. **Source:** [Radio Okapi](#)

Nigeria

04 March 2026: In Ngoshe village, Gwoza local government area, Borno state, a camp was attacked by armed men at around 1820hrs, abducting an unspecified number of people. **Source:** [All Africa](#)

Tanzania

24 March 2026: In Nduta Camp, Kibondo district, Kigoma region, an unspecified number of Burundian refugees were injured during attacks by unidentified armed men using guns, tear gas, and bladed weapons. **Source:** [African Public Radio](#)

Asia

Myanmar

11 March 2026: In Myingyan township and district, Mandalay region an unspecified number of IDP shelters were burned by Myanmar soldiers during an attack across three riverside villages. **Source:** [Personal Communication](#)

14 March 2026: At Palaw Tapo IDP Camp, near Thaugyin (Moei) River and Hpalu village tract, Myawaddy township and district, Kayin state, a makeshift clinic in the camp was damaged by two Myanmar military kamikaze drones at around 1030hrs. One was killed and another was critically injured. Lebanon

08 March 2026: In Ain al-Hilweh Refugee Camp, south of Saida city, South governorate, an Israeli airstrike killed and injured an unspecified number of people. **Sources:** [France-Guyane](#), [Quds News Network](#) and [Quds News Network II](#)

04 March 2026: In Al Buss Camp, Beirut city and governorate, Israeli forces issued mass forced displacement orders. **Source:** [Medical Aid for Palestinians](#)

05 March 2026: In Burj al Barajneh Camp, Beirut city and governorate, Israeli forces issued mass forced displacement orders. **Source:** [Medical Aid for Palestinians](#)

17 March 2026: In Tyre city and district, South governorate, Rashidieh Camp, Al-Bass Camp, Burj al-Shamali Camp, Al-Maashouq Camp, and Jal al-Bahr Camp, were issued evacuation warnings by Israeli forces, causing mass displacement in the area. **Source:** [Jinha Agency](#)

24 March 2026: In Mieh Mieh Refugee Camp, Sidon city, South governorate, a home was hit by an Israeli airstrike, killing two people, including a woman and injuring four others. **Sources:** [Palestinian Refugee Portal](#), [Quds News Network](#), [Quds News Network I](#), [26 September](#) and [Shourouk News](#)

Makeshift camps in Gaza

03 March 2026: Near Al-Nas roundabout, Khan Yunis city and governorate, a tent sheltering IDPs was hit by an Israeli drone strike, killing and injuring an unspecified number of people. **Source:** [Quds News Network](#)

04 March 2026: In Al Mawasi area, Rafah governorate, tents sheltering IDPs were fired upon by Israeli forces, injuring two people. **Source:** [Quds News Network](#)

09 March 2026: In Al Zawaida town, Deir al-Balah governorate, a tent sheltering IDPs was hit by an Israeli airstrike, killing three Palestinians, including a female journalist and a 12-year-old girl. **Sources:** [Quds News Network](#) and [Watan Serb](#)

11 March 2026: In Gaza city and governorate, tents sheltering IDPs near the Qatari ambassador's office caught fire due to an Israeli airstrike on a building. **Sources:** [Quds News Network](#) and [Wafa](#)

13 March 2026: In the east Khan Yunis city, Khan Yunis governorate, tents sheltering IDPs were fired upon by Israeli tanks, killing and injuring an unspecified number of people. **Source:** [Quds News Network](#)

15 March 2026: In Al Mawasi area, Khan Yunis governorate, a wall from the damaged Al-Ribat College building, previously bombed by Israeli forces, collapsed onto tents sheltering IDPs, killing three people, including a child and injuring an unspecified number of others. **Sources:** [Quds News Network](#), [Quds News Network I](#) and [The Palestinian Information Center](#)

23 March 2026: In Al Mawasi area, Khan Yunis governorate, tents sheltering IDPs were fired upon by Israeli forces, injuring an unspecified number of people. **Source:** [Quds News Network](#)

24 March 2026: In Al Mawasi area, Khan Yunis governorate, tents sheltering IDPs were fired upon by Israeli forces, killing a child. **Sources:** [Quds News Network](#) and [Wafa](#)

25 March 2026: In Al-Sitt Amira makeshift camp, Deir al-Balah city and governorate, the camp was hit by an Israeli airstrike, killing a man and injuring seven others. **Sources:** [Quds News Network](#), [Quds News Network I](#) and [Wafa](#)

25 March 2026: In Khan Yunis city and governorate, tents sheltering IDPs were fired upon by Israeli naval boats, injuring an unspecified number of Palestinians. **Sources:** [Quds News Network](#) and [Quds News Network I](#)

26 March 2026: In Halawa makeshift camp, Jabalia governorate, an unspecified number of IDPs were fired upon by Israeli forces, injuring five people, including a child and a woman. **Source:** [Quds News Network](#)

26 March 2026: In Rimal neighbourhood, Gaza city and governorate, parts of Al-Shawa and Al-Hasri towers, which shelter IDPs, collapsed due to Israeli artillery shelling in the area, damaging shelters. **Source:** [Wafa](#)

30 March 2026: In Rafah city and governorate, tents sheltering IDPs were fired upon by Israeli helicopters. **Source: Quds News Network**

30 March 2026: In Khan Yunis city and governorate, tents sheltering IDPs were fired upon by Israeli helicopters. **Source: Quds News Network**

31 March 2026: In Halawa makeshift camp, Jabalia governorate, two people, including a child, were injured by Israeli forces gunfire. **Source: Quds News Network**
